Course Synopsis

ART 2360 surveys 700 years in the history of art from 1300 to 2000. This course addresses painting, sculpture, and architecture from Europe, the United States, and selected non-Western cultures. Kelly Donahue-Wallace, an associate professor of art history and Chair of Art Education and Art History, and Denise Baxter, assistant professor, previously taught the course in a large-lecture format. They redesigned the course to emphasize active learning and to put students in contact with works of art and architecture. Drs. Donahue-Wallace and Baxter developed examples of course outcomes and assessment activities that include creative problem solving, peer interaction, and community activities. The assessments will be reviewed by external authorities to ensure that UNT students are achieving the course goals.
